The **very first** Ukrainian web portal, [mapa.net.ua](http://mapa.net.ua), was created for identifying **illegal carriers** – with verification carried out via **Diia**.



IACBS has become a platform for communication between **government and business, bus stations and carriers**, paving the way for innovative approaches to passenger transportation.

# IACBS and Legislative Activities



Our team has developed:



a global concept for **reforming passenger transportation and adapting it to EU legislation**;



amendments to the Rules for the provision of passenger road transport services (**CMU Resolution 176**) aimed at creating a List of bus stations and preventing the operation of illegal stations;



amendments to harmonize the powers of **Ukrtransbezpeka** regarding the List of Bus Stations (by amending the Regulation on the State Service of Ukraine for Transport Safety – **CMU Resolution 103**).



As a result of numerous working meetings and consultations, we successfully initiated the consideration of draft **law No. 4560** committee – aimed at aligning relevant legislation with EU standards.



Our work on increasing the liability of illegal carriers also spurred the registration of draft **law No. 11025** in a Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, designed to strengthen penalties for violations of passenger transportation procedures and counteract illegal services.



# IACBS and the Authorities



We have established a close cooperation with key central executive bodies, including:

- Ministry for Development of Communities and Territories of Ukraine,
- Ministry of Economy of Ukraine,
- Ministry of Social Policy of Ukraine,
- Ministry of Veterans Affairs of Ukraine,
- Ministry of Digital Transformation of Ukraine,
- State Service of Ukraine for Transport Safety,
- State Agency for the Restoration and Development of Infrastructure of Ukraine
- Recovery and Reform Support Team (RST) at the Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine.



Cooperation with Legislative Bodies:

- the Committee on Transport and Infrastructure of the Verkhovna Rada,
- the Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Customs Policy of the Verkhovna Rada,
- the Committee on Law Enforcement of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.



IACBS initiated the **digitalization of targeted compensation** for privileged passenger transportation in the Poltava region. A beneficiary account, smart card, and digital process—from ticket purchase to compensation—are currently under development.



Furthermore, IACBS collaborates with local governments to **strengthen oversight of passenger transportation legislation** and to develop draft regulatory acts:

- Kyiv City State Administration,
- Kyiv Regional State Administration,
- Mukachevo City Council, etc.

# IACBS web portal

Our unique web portal lets you **check whether a bus is legal**, **report an illegal carrier** (this information is automatically forwarded to regional departments of the State Service of Ukraine for Transport Safety), and **write a review** of your trip – to build the most reliable rating of carriers.



The system is integrated with the databases of **Ukrtransbezpeka** and the Ministry of Internal Affairs. Once verified via **Diia** (or through a **Google account, email, or phone number**), anyone can check any vehicle.



A real-time, interactive map of Ukraine displays **lists of legal bus stations** by region, analytics on the **numbers of legal and illegal carriers**, and estimates how much tax revenue is lost in each region. The map is updated in real time depending on the data collection.
